Sub: Felling/ Regeneration Activities to be undertaken during the year 2020-21 in Nine Forest Project Divisions- regarding.

Sir,

The undersigned is directed to refer to your office letter No. Desk-PLN/F & R Proposal/2020-21/CR.10/p-1/2350 dated 07.01.2021 on the above subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government and to say that the said proposal has been examined and recommended by the Regional Empowered Committee constituted under Section - 4 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

After detailed examination and discussion on the proposal of Managing Director, FDCM Ltd. the Committee decided to recommend to approve the proposal for felling/ Regeneration Activities to be undertaken during the year 2020-21 in Nine Forest Project Divisions by FDCM Ltd., as per following details:

The approval is subject to following conditions:

- i. The budget as made available by the State Govt. for this purpose in the current financial year for carrying out different operations shall be ensured for full achievements of targets especially regeneration. No CAMPA funds shall be utilized for any such regeneration.
- ii. Supplementary proposal for felling shall have to be sent to the Ministry for undertaking additional felling in the Divisions where Working Plan shall be approved during the year and also where felling permission has been not approved.
- iii. Fund allotment for regeneration work should be enhanced to the extent estimated by Working Plan Officers. In case no estimate is available in the Working Plan, the fund should be allotted on the basis of the site specific plan for regeneration.
- iv. Efforts shall be made to involve people's participation through JFMC's in all forestry works.



- v. If no regeneration can be carried out in an area, due to law and order or any other reason, then no felling should be carried out in an equivalent area.
- vi. There shall be no clear felling and plantations be taken up in areas with crown density 0.4 and above.
- vii. FDCM shall strictly follow the following recommendation as suggested by MoEF&CC, New Delhi vide letter dated 02.08.2001 for Teak Plantation and Reboisement Working Circle:
 - a. All young to middle aged fruit bearing trees up to 20 trees/ha. should be retained.
 - b. Young to middle aged trees of semal, khair, rosewood and other superior miscellaneous species up to 20 trees/ha. uniformly spread over the areas should be retained.
 - c. No felling should be done on either side of nala, streams, and river banks up to the 20 m distance.
 - d. The section size at a place should not be exceeding 20 ha.
 - e. 5 meter wide strip of natural forest should be retained on all sides of the section.
 - f. Effective measures should be adopted to protect the plantation from fires for all times to come.
 - g. Improved planting stock should be used in order to increase the productivity
- viii. Appropriate and effective measures should be undertaken for the conservation of biodiversity by protecting local RET species of area and wildlife management by protecting and maintaining all meadows and fruit bearing trees.
- ix. The orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of Godavarman Thirumulkpad Vs Union of India in W.P. (Civil) No. 202/95 and related interlocutory applications shall be strictly adhered to. Any prescription or operation at variance with the Hon'ble Supreme Court's order shall be kept in abeyance till the order is in force or otherwise modified.
- x. Further, in compliance with the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 22.09.2000, the Government of Maharashtra shall ensure that regeneration of forest is commensurate with the felling carried out under this working plan.
- xi. The FDCM shall follow the principle of sustainable management and precautionary principle as proponent by Hon'ble Supreme Court and Hon'ble NGT in various pronouncements.
- xii. A comprehensive analysis of estimated yield and actual yield should be undertaken. The reasons for shortfall/excess yield should be analysed and measures taken to minimize the difference.
- xiii. Reconstruction of boundary pillars may be done so as to complete the works in selected coupes taken up in a year rather than scattering it in the whole State.
- xiv. No commercial felling shall be carried out along the 2 km strip of all perennial Rivers of State; further, no commercial felling shall be carried out along the strip of 500 meters of all seasonal Rivers; only eco-restoration work shall be carried out.
- xv. No commercial felling shall be carried out in the Divisions where working plan is not in operation.

- xvi. No deviations shall be made from the prescriptions of Working Plan without prior approval of the Central Government under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. However, deviations of positive nature i.e. voluntary plantations carried out outside the working area under any project, schemes and compensatory afforestation may be approved by the competent authority of the State Government from time to time.
- xvii. Fruit bearing naturally grown trees shall not be cleared felled.
- xviii. Silvicultural operations including thinning shall be done under direct supervision of an officer not below the rank of Assistant Conservator of Forests.
- xix. Efforts should be made to undertake artificial regeneration of local species as well as RET species in such a way that it serves the purpose of biodiversity conservation as well as meeting the demand of fuel wood, fodder and the timber. Planting of exotic species should be avoided.
- xx. All kinds of felling including dead, dying, diseased trees, for granting of right and concession, illicit felling and felling mandated under FCA approval shall be accounted for against the prescribed felling yield of the relevant year.
- xi. Demarcation and consolidation of forests shall be done adequately in time bound manner.
- xxii. The Central Government reserves the right to review/modify/withdraw, this approval at any time if any condition of this approval is not implemented. Relevant modifications in the annual plan are required to be carried out so as to keep it in conformity with the orders, circulars and guidelines issued by the Central Government or the Apex Court under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 or any other statute and National Forest Policy from time to time.

This issues with the approval of Regional Officer (Central), Integrated Regional Office (WCZ), MoEF & CC, Nagpur.


