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Subject: Procurement and Supply of Honey on White-Label Basis for Marketing under FDCM Brand

Forest Development Corporation of Maharashtra Limited (FDCM), a Government of Maharashtra Enterprise, intends to procure quality honey from established and eligible honey manufacturers/processors/suppliers for marketing and retail sale under the FDCM brand.

Accordingly, quotations are invited from interested and eligible firms/enterprises having valid FSSAI Registration/License and requisite facilities and experience for manufacturing/processing and supply of honey.

1. Scope of Supply

The selected firm/supplier shall:

1. Supply quality honey conforming to the applicable FSSAI standards and food safety requirements.
2. Possess a valid FSSAI Registration/License applicable to the manufacturing/processing/supply activity.
3. Have adequate quality-control and laboratory testing arrangements and undertake periodic/batch-wise testing as applicable.
4. Supply the honey in the pack sizes, packaging material and specifications approved by FDCM.
5. Supply the product for sale under the FDCM brand on a white-label basis.
6. Provide batch-wise/relevant laboratory test reports and other quality documents as required by FDCM.
7. Ensure that every batch supplied conforms to the agreed specifications and applicable statutory standards.

FDCM shall undertake the marketing, distribution and retail sale of the honey under its own brand.

2. Eligibility

The quotationer should possess:

- Valid FSSAI Registration/License;
- Established honey manufacturing/processing/packing facility;
- Adequate quality-control and testing arrangements;
- Valid GST and PAN registration;
- Experience in manufacturing/processing and supply of honey; and
- Capacity to supply the required quantity regularly.

3. Quality Assurance

The supplier shall be responsible for ensuring the quality and safety of the honey supplied.

FDCM reserves the right to get the supplied product tested through an independent laboratory. If any batch is found to be sub-standard, adulterated or not conforming to the agreed specifications/applicable standards, FDCM may reject the batch and require its replacement at the supplier's cost.

4. Price Quotation

The quotationer shall quote the per-unit price for the supply of honey, clearly indicating:

- Product cost;
- Packaging and labelling cost;
- Applicable GST;
- Transportation/freight charges, if any; and
- Any other applicable charges.

The quotation should clearly mention the net rate payable by FDCM per pack/unit.

The required quantity and pack sizes shall be communicated by FDCM based on its requirement and market demand.

5. Documents to be Submitted

The quotation shall be accompanied by self-attested copies of:

1. Firm/Company Registration Certificate;
2. Valid FSSAI Registration/License;
3. GST Registration Certificate;
4. PAN Card;
5. Details of manufacturing/processing facility;
6. Recent honey laboratory test report(s);
7. Details of experience in honey manufacturing/supply; and
8. Technical and commercial quotation.

6. Contract/Procurement Period

The initial procurement arrangement, if finalized, may be extended subsequently with the approval of the competent authority of FDCM and subject to mutually agreed terms and conditions.
